2024 Oil Region Historic Preservation Awards

The Awards Program:

Recognizes projects that represent the appropriate standards of preservation, restoration, and rehabilitation.

Acknowledges individuals, services, or commitment to the preservation of historic resources.

Creates an advocacy for historic preservation through a greater public awareness of the built environment.

Enhances a region-wide preservation ethic in both the public and private sectors.

Nomination Rules:

- Persons and historic resources in the Oil Region National Heritage Area are eligible (all of Venango County, and the City of Titusville, Hydetown Borough, and Oil Creek Township in Crawford County).
- Buildings must be at least 50 years old, but do not need to be listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
- Previous award winners are not eligible for another award for five years.
- Nominations are viewed by a panel of judges comprised from heritage organizations.

Award Categories:

Adaptive Reuse — A process that adapts buildings for new uses while retaining their key historic features.

Enhancement — Restoration and/or rehabilitation of historic building elements and appropriate application of colors, materials, and other amenities.

Historic Appreciation — Projects or efforts that promote the preservation and celebration of history.

Preservation Education/Initiative — Service or commitment by a group, individual, or business that promotes preservation education or preservation of the built environment.

Preservation Stewardship — Sensitive long-term care of a historic resource.

Reconstruction — Restoration or substantial rehabilitation of a historic resource.

Residence — Restoration or rehabilitation of historic single- or multi-family residences.

Structure — Restoration or rehabilitation of a historic resource that is not a building. Examples: bridges, fountains, memorials, gardens, etc.
